Nikkei Business, Japan most popular business weekly magazine, has recently selected and published 100 best respected Japanese companies based upon a new assessment formula: CSR-Corporate Social Responsibility. A good company is now defined by not only its economic strength, but also by how it is respected by the people. The new assessment formula includes three elements of corporation behaviors and achievements. These are the environment aspect, social aspect and economic aspect of corporation activities.

Fireflies and Liquid Crystal Television

Japan's summer is full of beautiful fireworks in cities and fireflies or glowworms in the county side. Genji firefly (Academic name : chrysochroa fuigidissima) is a kind of most popular insects emitting light while it flies in the summer night.

The light-emitting principle of the firefly is the same as that of Liquid Crystal Display. Remember the principle was first discovered more than 100 years ago by German ands Czech scientists and was first product-tested by RCA in 1962.
