Privatization Process and Kaizen

From April 1, 2004, all 78 national universities of Japan are converted into private corporations independent from national control as the privatization process (or Min-eika).

This departure from national ownership means sever competition among themselves to survive. Only efficient and well-managed universities can survive because no government protection is guaranteed anymore. It's been widely disputed in Japan that Kaizen implementation is very poor in the three sections of Japanese society: universities, government offices and hospitals because they are overly protected. They did not care about their customers!! They are just snobbish, ego-centric and full of "red tapes". But over 10-15 years many national institutions such as Japan Post, Japan Railway Company were privatized and hospitals are using Kaizen to eliminate Muda. For example, Ohta City of Gumma Prefecture has decided to open libraries 7 days a week to give maximum service to its citizens. One of the last opponents was the national university.

In the United States jails are run by private companies. I don't' think it good. It goes too far!!
